

PROCUREMENT (FUEL IMPORT) LICENSES

REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSING – SECTION 29 AND 30 OF THE PETROLEUM ACT (CHAPTER 13:22) OF 2006

The Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) hereby notifies all fuel operators that the Authority will be accepting 2022 applications for procurement (fuel import) licenses under the following conditions whilst consultations with Government are being finalised:

1. 2022 procurement (fuel import) license fees

- i. The license fee is USD24 360 excluding VAT.
- Please take note that payment of license fees into the ZERA account without submitting adequate application documents does not warrant the issuance of a license.

2. 2022 procurement license applications

Applicants must provide the following:

- a. Completed application form
- Evidence of importation of at least 10 million litres (combined product) into the market in 2021 (or any year between 2017 and 2020) or
- Evidence of ownership (through title deeds) or management (through lease, assignment, transfer or cession) of a minimum of 3 licensed retail sites.

3. Application process
