

## RENEWAL OF PETROLEUM LICENSES

REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSING - SECTION 29 OF THE PETROLEUM ACT (CHAPTER 13:22) OF 2006 AND SECTION 32 (g) OF THE ENERGY REGULATORY AUTHORITY ACT

The Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority (ZERA) hereby notifies fuel operators whose 2022 operating licenses expire on 31 December 2022 to start the renewal process through applying for new licenses for 2023.

In that regard, ZERA hereby advises on the following:

- Applications for 2023 licensing year must be submitted via email on (i) licensing@zera.co.zw in PDF format only and below 10MB in size.
- All applicants for renewal of licenses are required to submit the duly (ii) completed license renewal form accompanied by the requisite supporting documents.
- (iii) License fees for 2023 are as follows:

License category	USD (VAT Exclusive)
Wholesale license	9 200
Retail license	500 (Urban) 200 (Rural)
Production license (Mandatory)	20 000
Production license (General)	20 000
Production license (Blending)	5 000
LPG Retail license	100
LPG Wholesale license	8 000

- Please take note that payment of license fees into the ZERA (iv) account without submitting adequate application documents does not warrant the issuance of a license.
- Application forms and lists of requirements are available for (v) download at www.zera.co.zw

All operators are reminded that according to section 29 of the Petroleum Act, it is illegal to procure, sell or produce any petroleum product without a license issued by the Authority and the necessary steps will be taken on those that do not comply.
